

## CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE – POPs Declaration –

Persistent organic pollutants (POPs) are organic substances that persist in the environment, accumulate in living organisms, and pose a risk to our health and the environment. These substances are regulated by the 2001 Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants<sup>1</sup> or the 1979 Geneva Convention on Long-Range Transboundary Air Pollution (LRTAP), with the addition of the 1998 Aarhus Protocol on Persistent Organic Pollutants<sup>2</sup>. The requirements of these UN treaties have been implemented in the European Union under the Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 on persistent organic pollutants (recast), and its amendments<sup>3</sup>.

NXP semiconductor products<sup>4</sup> do not contain intentionally added POPs<sup>1,2,3</sup>, above their maximum concentration limits in the specified applications. NXP Semiconductors Netherlands B.V. certifies that, to the best of its knowledge, NXP semiconductor products<sup>4</sup> (including subcomponents such as die encapsulants, substrates, adhesives, etc.) are compliant to these UN Treaties and the EU Regulation on POPs.
